Rules Corner

What's a concession? Concessions are in Match Play - A player may concede the opponent's next stroke, a hole or the match.

Conceding Next Stroke - this is allowed any time before the opponent's next stroke.

Conceding a Hole - this is allowed any time before the hole is completed, including before the players start the hole.

Conceding the Match - this is allowed any time before the result of the match is decided, including before the players even start the match.

Any concession is final and cannot be declined or withdrawn.
