Rules Corner

How many club lengths to measure when taking relief?

This is a regular everyday occurrence on the golf course. You have some marked GUR, a staked tree, an unplayable ball, relief from a path or relief from a penalty area. Players very often get confused or simply don't understand the different approach in assessing where their relief area will be or the size of the relief area.



Let's see if we can simplify things here:-

- FREE RELIEF is only ever ONE club length relief area
- PENALTY RELIEF is always TWO club lengths relief area for lateral relief
- NEVER is there a situation where there is more than TWO club lengths

Let's see which measurement applies to which situation.

FREE RELIEF - Abnormal Course Conditions — paths, GUR, staked trees, animal scrapings, immovable obstructions, temporary water etc. These are all situations where the condition is interfering with your stance, swing or simply the lie of the ball. Players get FREE relief from these situations. They must first find their Nearest Point of Complete Relief [the spot where if your ball was on it there would be NO interference from the condition] The player now has a ONE club length relief area from this reference point to drop in — which must be no nearer the hole and the ball must remain in the relief area.

FREE RELIEF – Embedded ball in the General Area [means all the course except penalty areas, bunkers, tee and green of hole being played] In this situation the players reference point to measure from is directly behind the spot of the embedded original ball. The relief area is ONE club length from this point, again no nearer the hole and the ball must remain in the relief area when dropped.

PENALTY RELIEF – Unplayable Ball or Penalty Areas. Remember for both of these conditions Lateral [sideways] relief is only one option, players can always go back-on-line or back to where the last stroke was made. A ONE stroke penalty applies for both conditions with the exception of an unplayable ball in a bunker and the player chooses to drop outside the bunker then a TWO stroke penalty applies.

Unplayable Ball – if taking lateral relief the relief area is measured from where the ball lies and the size of the relief area is TWO club lengths from this point.

Penalty Areas – if taking lateral relief the relief area is measured from the reference point of where the ball last crossed the margin of the penalty area. The size of this relief area is TWO club lengths from this point.
